Although some people may confuse Memorial Day with Veterans Day, these two are different. While Memorial Day honors those who died during their service, Veterans Day has its own history. Veterans Day was originally called Armistice Day to commemorate the end of World War I. In 1918, on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month, that is November 11, fighting came to an end between the Allied nations and Germany when an armistice was put into effect. Thus, November 11, 1918 was considered the end of "the war to end all wars". Later, the U.S. congress recognized November 11 as a day to honor World War I veterans. However, after World War II and the Korean War, Congress decided to change the word "armistice" to "veterans". Throughout the years, there were a couple of other changes to this day but today, November 11 honors veterans of all wars for their sacrifices and patriotism.

Most local veterans served for five years or less (70.5%).

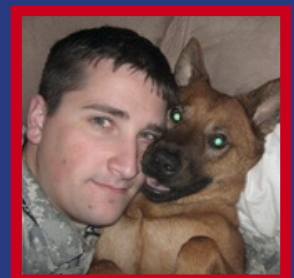
